NASA scientist attends medium's 'Boot Camp' in the Bahamas

MEDIUM Robert Brown has held his eleventh annual 'Boot Camp' in the Bahamas.

"This is our eleventh Boot Camp and was once again a great success," Robert told *Psychic News*. "The aim has always been to give those who are working as mediums, and those who are seeking to enhance and develop their own abilities, an opportunity to come together, share and learn from each other."

Robert has run both Boot Camps and larger-scale retreats for many years now.

"We always set a limit of 45 participants at the Boot Camp, but this year we were overbooked and just managed to accommodate 47! Attendees came from all walks of life and from various countries. The majority were from America, and others came from France, Germany, Russia and the UK.

"The notable difference this year was the broad spectrum of the attendees' occupations. We had a NASA scientist, four medical doctors, three psychotherapists, two IT consultants, a surgeon, three lawyers, the owner of a multi-national advertising agency, one priest and five min-

isters, alongside office workers, home-makers, architects and a banker. Mediumship embraces all!"

This year Robert was joined as a facilitator by the former president of Fulham Spiritualist Church, Ann Burbidge.

"People were enthralled to learn about British Spiritualist churches and how they operate," said Robert.

"The week was such a success that already a booking list has opened for 2010! Each year we welcome some old faces but always some new ones as well. A number of the group have decided to visit the UK in 2010 to attend Spiritualist church services, and Mrs Burbidge has agreed to show them around.

"Classes and exercises in the development of mediumship, and how it is being instigated in different parts of the world, make these weeks invaluable for connecting the many mediums who live in countries where they do not have the support of Spiritualist churches."

Robert has now agreed to undertake an additional venture in the Bahamas, for which he will be joined by the American medium John Edward.

"In September 2009 we will launch the 'Mediums' Teacher-Training Course'. This will be for those who teach classes and courses," Robert explained.

"There does seem to be a call for some direction and unity to help lift the level of courses available around the world."

Carol continues research into helping the body to heal itself

CAROL EVERETT has dedicated her life to healing and easing pain. For 30 years she has worked as a clairvoyant, healer, researcher and writer. She and her husband, architect Mike Everett, live in Spain, and people from all over the world visit Carol in search of cures for their ills.

She never promises anything, except that she will tend anyone who needs her help.

In an interview with *Mediterranean Magazine* Carol was asked if she had ever proved that some of the 'incurable' diseases she treated turned out to be curable.

Her reply was: "Sometimes, yes, they really are curable. But other times you can only help to ease the situation. And on occasions you can help people to die."

"I remember a case when a woman came to me and, according to her doctor, was on the brink of dying. As soon as I sat down with her I told her she wasn't going to die, that I couldn't see her death.

"A year later she called me to request a clairvoyant appointment, and she was perfectly healthy."

Even as a child Carol realised that people felt better when they were around her. When she became an adult she thought it was coincidence. Later, as a clairvoyant, she began making diagnoses.

"It wasn't until much later that I began healing people," she said.

"Before that I worked for the police, and my name appeared in the papers.

"I travelled to Japan to work on some missing person cases, and agreed that the university could test my work. There I discovered that the healings were not simple coincidences. I then centred my work on healing people in mind, body and spirit."

Asked about the most frequent cases she dealt with, Carol replied: "Those deriving from the fact that either the doctors can no longer do anything for them, or when they admit they don't know what is wrong with them.

"I recently healed two people here [in Spain]. One was a 70-year-old who had suffered back pain since the age of eighteen as the result of an accident. He had been taking analgesics all that time. Now he doesn't take anything and is well.

"The other case was that of a former miner who had bad knees as a result of his work. After having a healing treatment the pain stopped."

When asked if she had any special technique by which she worked, Carol said she had been using a new technique for about three years.

"I believe blood has a 'memory'," she explained. "It circulates through the body, and the first step to making the body healthy is to stimulate and programme the blood.

"This has now been tested by some independent experts. The doctors from Tokyo University are very interested in it. A Swiss doctor and one in the United States are researching it, as it is something that had never been done before."

So in general, how do traditional medical doctors react? Carol says there is a mixed response.

"Some, in different countries, are very interested in this line of work. Others are curious and ask a lot of questions. And of course there are those who don't want to know or accept anything about it. Don't forget that scientists once believed the world was flat."

Carol would love to find the time to finish writing a book, perhaps produce a documentary, and continue researching and helping the body to heal itself.

Eventful investigation at opera house

PHOTOGRAPHS taken at a New Zealand opera house during a paranormal investigation were later mysteriously lost.

Clinton Lawson, who led the eight-strong team, Phoen-X Paranormal Research and Investigation, told *Hawke's Bay Today* that he and his team had taken 600-700 pictures during the investigation and downloaded them onto his laptop. The images had then been stored in a separate investigation folder.

"I had been looking at them

earlier in the evening but returned later to find all the photos gone," he said. "But no one had touched the laptop."

Other incidents included a shadow seen moving along a wall, a team member's watch skipping forward two hours, and seats left down in the theatre when no one was sitting on them.

Mr Lawson said the seats in the Hawke's Bay Opera House were "the counter-spring variety, so they could not stay down with no one sitting on them."

The team recorded very high electro-magnetic field readings in the booth where the rumoured 'Lady in Red' has been seen.

Several members smelt a woman's perfume in the opera house,

which was nothing like the air freshener and soaps in the toilets. "No one in our group was wearing perfume," he said.

"We've no doubt there is something inhabiting the building. We don't believe she is malevolent whatsoever - I think she gets bored."

Describing the investigation as "awesome", Mr Lawson said the team were planning to go back to the opera house in June.

"It had more activity than any investigation we've ever done before. I can't wait to get back there."

Opera house community events and venue manager Andrea Taaffe said she was not surprised by the findings.

"I'm just really happy to hear that whatever is having fun is not a particularly evil entity, just a bit cheeky at times!"
